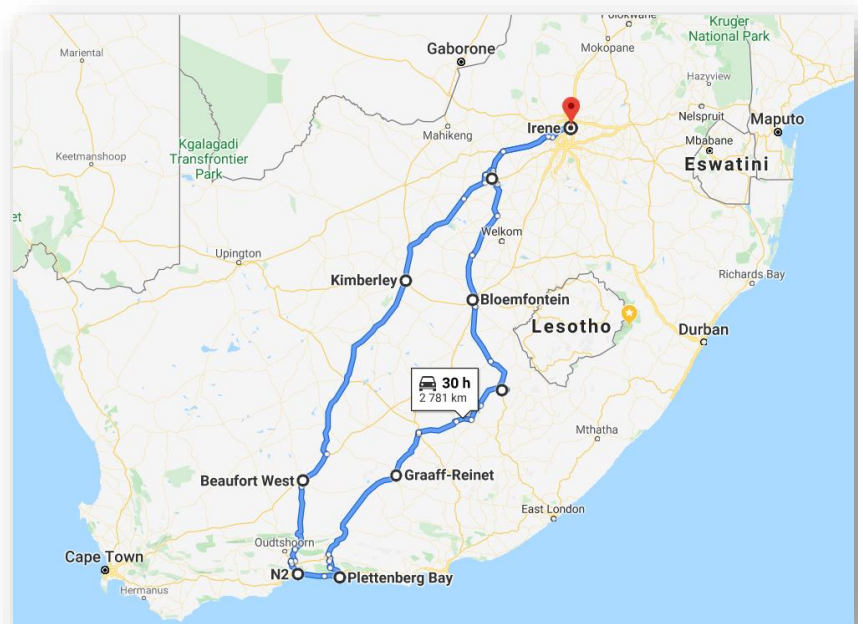

Itinerary*

Day 1

Our tour starts Johannesburg we head south towards Bloemfontein where we overnight.

Day 2

After breakfast, we leave the main route and head via the settlement at Nieu Bethesda and the Owl House, towards historic Graaf Reinet in the heart of the Karoo.

Day 3

After a morning ride through the Valley of Desolation outside Graaf Reinet, we head through Aberdeen and Uniondale to the coast and on to our next overnight in Plettenberg Bay – the start of the Garden Route.

Day 4

After breakfast, we travel along the N2 through the Knysna Elephant Park and over the Van Stadens Bridge to the coastal town of Knysna where we spend a leisurely night on the waterfront. This is an ideal opportunity to visit the motorcycle museum in Knysna.

Day 5

We spend the day exploring the coastal route visiting towns such as Sedgefield; the beaches of the Wilderness and the myriad of attractions and sights as we travel to George – the capital of the Garden Route. We overnight in George.

Day 6

After breakfast today, we start our road back home, travelling via Oudtshoorn and through the incredible Meiringspoort pass as we travel through the little Karoo and on to our next overnight stop in Beaufort West.

Day 7

The route takes us through Loxton and on to the historic city of Kimberley where we overnight after exploring some of the city and of course, the Big Hole.

Day 8

After breakfast, we head towards Bloemhof, Klerksdorp and Potchefstroom before reaching Johannesburg in the afternoon.
