## Itinerary\*

### Day 1

Today you head North from our base towards the Botswana border, travelling through the bushveld of the North-West Province before crossing into Botswana at the Kopfontein border post. After formalities, we continue onward to the capital city of Gaborone for our first overnight.

### Day 2

After breakfast, we head from Gaborone through the Kalahari to our next overnight stop in the Okavango itself. Here we experience what this unique biosphere offers while enjoying two nights at a lakeside lodge.

### Day 3

Today is an off-bike day to explore the delta in a little more detail. You have the opportunity to take a mokoro onto the lake as your guide floats you through elephants and hippo's to experience just why the Okovango has earned its reputation for serenity and relaxation. We spend a second night at he lodge.

### Day 4

After our stay in the Okavango, we head North once again towards the Namibian border where we enter the Caprivi through the Bwabwata National Park. We enjoy a brief stop at the Popa Falls before heading to our next overnight stay at a lodge on the Kavango River near Rundu.

### Day 5

Day four routes you south towards the Etosha National Park, one of the great game experiences on offer in southern Africa. After settling down for the night, we will enjoy an evening game drive and traditional dinner.

### Day 6

Today we spend an off-bike day exploring the Etosha in more depth with optional game rides and bush experiences. We end the day with a boma dinner at the lodge and experience local entertainment.

### Day 7

After our break in the Etosha, the tour continues south towards the coast and on to the seaside town of Swakopmund. We will spend an extra night in this quintessential German town to explore some of the most majestic dunes and coastal panorama's to be found on the continent.

### Day 8

Today we will spend exploring the area and visiting Walvis Bay where we have the opportunity to enjoy a short cruise or experience some of the world's highest sand dunes. We return to Swakopmund for the evening.

### Day 9

After the tranquillity of Swakopmund, our route travels inland and back to Windhoek, the capital of Namibia for a city tour and overnight stay. You will have the opportunity to experience local tastes and explore this small, yet dynamic city.

### Day 10

You start the return to South Africa, travelling east towards the South African border at Ariamsvlei before reaching Upington - the capital of the Northern Cape, for our final night.

### Day 11

Today's route takes us through the Northern Cape and back to our base in Johannesburg where we will arrive in the afternoon.
